

Carolina Landings - The Carolina Landings HOA Board of Directors announced in August that Communique' is the new property management company. Citing continued issues with RealManage since January when the company purchased Argus Property Management, the Board decided it was time for a change.

"This decision was made after three months of interviews with several management companies," said then President Linda Vreeland. "The Board realized that RealManage was not proactive in response to issues such as the Cooper Creek back-flow leak, among other issues."

Board Treasurer Val Mckillup met with Communique' founder and owner Maureen Schoening and Accountant Christina, and was impressed with their credentials and references. "Given that RealManage was only available by email, we certainly appreciate now, having an accountant to speak with directly about our association's financials," said Mckillup.

Since August 1, Communique' is completing all transfer of files and has begun to communicate with homeowners about their needs and issues that have long been ignored by RealManage.

The Board voted at the July HOA meeting that there will be no property manager in the Clubhouse office. Treasurer Val Mckillup explained that Carolina Landings will see a savings of about \$18,000 per year. Residents questioned how vehicle bar codes will be distributed. According to Maureen at Communique' they will mail programmed bar codes to residents.

The Board also voted to hire a maintenance service to clean the clubhouse, gym, pool area and restrooms, as well as bring out the recycle bins each week. The Board announced a savings of about \$2000 a month compared to hiring an on-site maintenance person.

Other previously neglected projects include trimming the large palms in front of the Clubhouse. White Diamond completed trimming the palms at the end of August. Powerwashing the Clubhouse was also recently completed.

HOA Board Hires Communique' Property Management

MANDATORY COMPLEX-WIDE WATER SHUT-OFF SCHEDULED

Carolina Landings - The back-flows throughout the complex will be bypassed to accommodate individual shut-offs at each building.

To do this, all units will experience a water shut-off on the days the bypasses are scheduled. Residents will be notified by email and signs by the entrance gates.

The water shut-offs to 4 to 5 buildings began at 8:30 AM on Tuesday, September 10. Water will be turned back on by 4:00 PM.

The new shut-offs are a significant savings to Carolina Landings and will help keep HOA fees low as reported by the Board and Communique'.

It was reported at the July Board meeting that the Association has paid over \$20,000 on back-flow repairs. When a back-flow fails, Daniels Plumbing will add a bypass - a cost of \$600 each - providing a significant savings over time, as aging back-flows fail.
